### MINUTES OF E C MEETING OF 19/01/2016

The members of State Committee of AIBPARC Karnataka met today at the Meeting Hall of AISBOF. The Meeting was presided over by Com.B T R Reddy. Com.Shantharaju, President, SBI Pensioners' Association took part in the Meeting. Welcoming the gathering Com.K B Ballur, Secretary, AIBPARC(K) informed the house about the progress made in respect of the various demands of the pensioners & Retirees of Banking Industry. An exhaustive note on the issues of pensioners. Viz.100 per cent DA Neutralisation, improvement in family pension and updation of Pension, has been placed before the Ministry of Finance and all the issues are under active consideration of the Central Govt. The issues of 100 per cent DA Neutralisation to the pre-01.11.2002 & Family improvement are likely to be considered very shortly. This apart the various Court cases are slated to be heard during the month of January, 2017. These developments have given clear indication that our hopes and aspirations are on the verge of getting settled. Further developments in this regard will be shared with the members after attending the AIBPARC Governing Council Meeting of AIBPARC @ Kolkata on 19th January, 2017.

Deliberating on the issues of pensioners Com. Shantharaju informed the house that now that the 11th Bipartite Settlement discussions will commence we should approach the leadership of AIBOC and NCBE and prevail upon them to pursue our issues seriously. He informed that the Charter of Demands of the pensioners has already been incorporated in the Charter of Demands to be submitted by AIBOC to IBA/ Govt. We also should insist that the Pensioners' Associations also should be involved in the negotiation process so that the issues of pensioners can be presented before IBA/Govt. in an effective manner. We have to continue to mount pressure on IBA to take up our issues for consideration with all earnestness. We should continue to agitate on these issues because without a fight nothing is given to us. Deliberating on the various issues connected with the IBA Medical Scheme, he stressed the need to create awareness among the members about the provisions of the Policy and people should be trained as to how to claim the hospitalisation bills properly. We can organise a Meeting of the members and impart necessary information on all issues concerning IBA Medical Scheme.

He suggested to hold the State Conference of AIBPARC in the month of February, 2017.

Com.Venjataraju H of Indian Bank Pensioners & Retirees Association gave a brief account of the 1st Annual General Body of their Association at Bengaluru on 18th Dec, 2016. The Conference was a big success and he informed the house that he has been re-elected as the General Secretary of AIBPARC(K) for the next tenure of three years. Com.B T R Reddy summarised the day's proceedings and suggested all the affiliates to meet once again during the first week of January, 2017.
