Suprita Sarkar, General Secretary, AIBPARC and All the guests were welcomed in the meeting by offering them flower bouquets by our comrades. While Com. Sarkar highlighted the pending issues of the pensioners in the Banking industry and the present status of the issues, Com. Com.Rampal, General Secreary, All India UCO Bank Pensioners Federation. The session was presided over by Com. Bipul Krishna Bandyopadhyay, President, All India UCO Bank Pensioners Federation.

After the end of the Inaugural Session, there was a break and then Delegate Session started. The Report of the General Secretary was placed before the delegates and observers along with the audited report for the period ended 31.3.2017. Receipts and payments accounts were also placed for the period from 1.4.2017 to 28.2.2018. During the discussion on the Report, strong protest were lodged by large section of members against wrongful reporting on affiliation to All India UCO Bank Officers' Federation and on Grievances Redressal Meeting wherein attempt was made to humiliate General Secretary, West Bengal Unit on wrong pretext. Comrade President then proposed to expunge these two points from the Report, which was unanimously approved by the House. Thus wrongful reporting on affiliation to All India UCO Bank Officers' Federation and Grievances Redressal Meeting were expunged from the Report of the General Secretary. After expunging these two points, the Report was passed by the House. Statements of accounts as placed in the House were also passed. Requisite constitution amendments were also placed and passed by the House.
